




Chelsea Groton Foundation Awards \$5,000 Grant to Operation Fuel

The Chelsea Groton Foundation has awarded a \$5,000 grant to Operation Fuel to use for energy assistance for households in New London County.

Operation Fuel is a statewide nonprofit organization that provides emergency energy assistance year-round to lower-income working families and individuals, the elderly, and disabled individuals who are in financial crisis. The Chelsea Groton Foundation was formed in June 1998 as a Section 501(c)(3) organization. The foundation initially was endowed with a \$2.8 million donation from Chelsea Groton Bank, and recently received an additional \$5 million from the bank.
